Die Staaten der 1957 gegründeten Europäischen Wirtschaftsgemeinschaft (EWG) fallen teilweise in eine nationale Wirtschaftspolitik zurück. Der deutsche Nationalökonom Herbert Giersch prägt in diesem Zusammenhang den Begriff der "Eurosclerosis". Intensiviert wird die Konjunkturschwächung durch die Ölkrise in Folge des Jom-Kippur-Kriegs 1973 und der iranischen Revolution 1979. Hinzu tritt die internationale Währungskrise, die 1973 durch

den Zusammenbruch des Bretton-Woods-Systems ausgelöst wird und zu grossen Wechselkursschwankungen zwischen den europäischen Ländern führt. Sie enthält unter anderem das Projekt eines gemeinsamen europäischen Binnenmarkts mit weitgehend einheitlichen Regeln und Wettbewerbsbedingungen und zieht damit die politischen Konsequenzen aus den Erfahrungen während der Krise. Vor allem aber enthält die EEA eine erste Erweiterung der Kompetenzen des Europäischen Parlaments und die Wiederaufnahme des 1969 in Den Haag beschlossenen Plans einer Europäischen Politischen Zusammenarbeit zur ausserpolitischen Koordinierung der EWG-Staaten. Seit 1970 besteht eine informelle Zusammenarbeit im ausserpolitischen Bereich, die im sog. "Davignon-Bericht" grundiert.
